


BRACHYCEPHALY: What Are The Signs?



BRACHYCEPHALY: What are the signs



Viewing from the side of the head look for flattening in the back of the head and an upwardly sloping forehead.

From the front the head will be wide ear to ear. The facial symmetry is usually good



TO SUMMARIZE THE SIGNS OF BRACHYCEPHALY

A head presenting with a short frontal to occipital length.

A wide width ear to ear.

An upwardly sloping skull from forehead to occiput when viewed from the side.

Often the result of supine positioning after birth.
