

Patient Care Standards

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The NiC BAND Program is a set of eleven standards of care and service. Each one was developed with the needs of a rapidly changing individual, your infant, in mind. Every patient within the NiC BAND Program will be entitled to the following:

- 1. An appointment for evaluation within 3 days of the initial call to our office.
- 2. Delivery of the NiC BAND within 10 days of scanning your baby.
- 3. A secretary will investigate your insurance coverage, gather all medical documentation and assist in a parent's efforts to appeal any denial of coverage.
- 4. A foam carving made from the scan of the infants asymmetrical head will be given to the parents.
- 5. An exit scan comparison of the before and after treatment will be created at the end of treatment.
- 6. Measurements will be recorded at every follow-up.
- 7. A Tracer Scan of the infants head will be made to fabricate the NiC BAND. This is a class I Laser device that is FDA approved for use on infants and is safe for the eyes. It is very similar to a grocery scanner.
- 8. A comprehensive care and use guide will be provided at delivery.
- 9. A practitioner will be available 24/7 for emergencies and questions.
- 10. Adjustments will be scheduled within 48 hours of a call to our office.
- 11. Follow-ups will be scheduled at 1-2 week intervals depending on the starting age of the infant.
