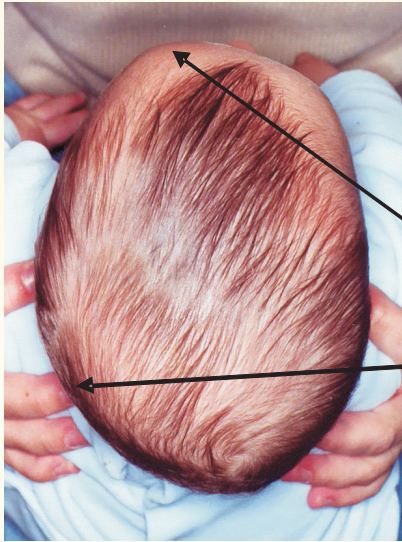


PLAGIOCEPHALY: What are the signs

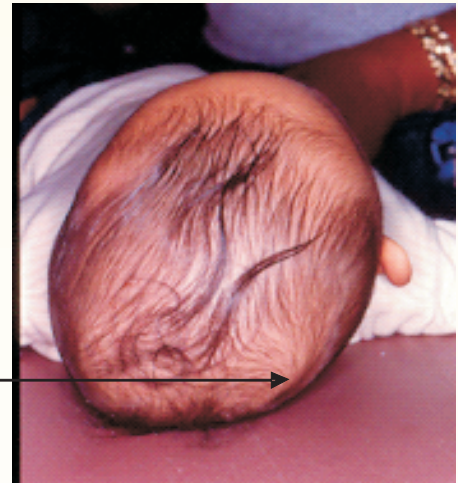


Viewing from the top of the head look for flattening in the back of the head, bulging of the forehead on the same side as the flattening and a forward shift of the ear on the side of the flattening.

Bulging Forehead

Flattened side of the head

This is how Plagiocephaly starts, the soft infant skull lying against the hard mattress.



TO SUMMARIZE THE SIGNS OF PLAGIOCEPHALY:

- Head shape in the form of a parallelogram.
- Bulging of the forehead on the side as the posterior flattening.
- The ear on the flattened side is pushed forward toward the face.
