

Turricephaly : What are the signs?



In Turricephaly or Tall Head, there is an elongation of the top/posterior of the skull. The skull is otherwise symmetrical with minor ridging at the suture sites. In the presence of Torticollis or other anomaly, a Plagiocephalic shape can occur in addition to the turricephaly.



As seen from the top the skull is symmetrical. Cranial remodeling has little if any effect on Turricephaly. Should there be an associated plagiocephaly or brachycephaly condition a cranial helmet would be warranted.
